

President's Message




On behalf of Choose Life

MAID for Mental Illness-2nd Possible Pause

Amid widespread public concern, the Justice Minister Arif Virani recently stated that the Federal government is again considering a pause from implementing euthanasia for mental illness that was set to proceed March 17, 2024. In response, the Euthanasia Prevention Coalition (EPC) has developed a postcard campaign to convince the government to actually *reverse* their plans. Together let's show the government that we oppose euthanasia for mental illness by sending the enclosed postcard to the Justice Minister or your Liberal MP as soon as possible since parliament will be reconvening at the end of January.

Alex Schadenberg stressed that if we are complacent, euthanasia for mental illness will eventually become law despite possible numerous pauses. There is no consensus on the topic among the psychiatric community who say, "it is not possible to determine that a person with a mental illness has an 'irremediable medical condition' as is required in the law."



Fourth Annual Report on MAID, 2022

13,241 died by lethal injection. (31.2% increase from 2021) That's 4.1% of all Canadian deaths in 2022. 17.1% of people who chose MAID did so because they were isolated or lonely. Canada's harrowing euthanasia experiment should be a warning to the world.
